It is funded by mandatory annual dues paid by all homeowners in sections 6-10 of the Village of Mount Carmel.

VOMC, Inc Accomplishments 2021-2022

- Replaced tennis court halogen lights with LED lights; much better lighting and significant savings on electricity usage
- Replaced parking lot sodium vapor lights with LED lights
- · Repaired gas line leak inside the clubhouse walls
- · Replaced burned-out hot water heater element
- Removed significant amounts of deadwood south of the creek




- · Replaced old pool slide with a much safer, sturdier slide
