VOMC, Inc Accomplishments 2022-2023

- Replaced and improved electrical panel and wiring in clubhouse pump room.
- Replaced burned-out hot water heater element and fixed faulty connection to restroom.
- Established contract with C&N Pools in order to continue pool service at a contained cost. Pool service include lifeguards, monitoring and adjusting water quality daily.
- Coordinated with the VOMC Social Committee to host new and continue long-standing neighborhood social events at the pool and common grounds throughout the year.
